Case Details (Description)	On 8th August, our Thirupathur Neonatal Ambulance received a call from ERO at 05:51hrs stating that Baby of Indrakumari, 1 days old male neonate with birth weight of 2.3kg. At birth baby was not cried and resuscitated with bag valve mask ventilation with oxygen, after a minute baby got spontaneous breathing. Baby was referred from Vellakalnatham PHC to Thirupathur GH, for the complaints of Severe Birth Asphyxia and Thick Meconium Aspiration. Immediately our NEMT Vidya reached the scene at 06:43hrs. She received the neonate from the GH staff and assessed the neonate. The neonate was in Shock, Severe respiratory distress and Hypoglycemia. The vitals were Skin color- Pale, CRT->3sec, Temperature - 30.2 C, HR- 92beats/min, Cry and Movements- absent, RR-64breaths/min, SpO2- 78% (without oxygen), 88% (with oxygen), Grunting- Present, DOWNES score-8/10, CBG-22mg/dl. NEMT placed the baby in incubator and Sniffing position was maintained. Oxygen administered through Oxygen prongs. As per NERCP Dr. Vidya advice normal saline bolus dose given to manage the shock. 10% Dextrose bolus dose give to manage the hypoglycemia. After the administration of IV fluid, baby got the stable vitals. Enroute to the hospital vitals were Skin color- Pink, CRT- <3sec, Temperature - 36.5C, HR- 148beats/min, Cry and Movements- absent, RR-64breaths/min, SpO2- 94% (with oxygen), Grunting-Present,DOWNES score- 8/10, CBG-62mg/dl.Frequent suction was done. Enroute to the hospital vitals were monitored. Then the Neonate was safely shifted to Thirupathur GH with the stable vitals after prehospital care. After a week baby got discharged with good health to home.

- *- Ineffective Calls Calls falling under the category of No Response call , Wrong call , Nuisance, Disconnected call , Missed call , General Enquiry call, and Silent Call are classified as Ineffective calls. These calls land in the call center and when attended by the Communication Officer it would either be a nuisance call or disconnected call or any one of the category as mentioned above.
- ** Ambulance Busy Whenever all the ambulances closer to the area have been assigned for an emergency case, and a new emergency case comes in the same area, the Dispatch Officer will enquire with the caller, if he/she can assign a ambulance from the nearby location. The Dispatch Officer will also tell them about the distance the ambulance has to travel and the approximate time it will take to reach the incident location. If the caller is not willing to wait till the specified time, then the Dispatch officer will close this case as "Ambulance Busy" after confirming with the caller.

*** - Life Saved count is an update that is received on a daily basis after verification of PCR and confirmation after 48 hour follow-up, there will be a change in the numbers reported as they keep on adding to the earlier reported life save count, based on the date the case was handled by the team.
