As per ERCP advice, oxygen 3l was administered through nasal cannula and 10% D with 4.2ml/hr was maintained.  Twin 2: The vitals were skin color-pink, temperature-warm, CRT- <3 sec, T- 36C, HR-148b/m, RR- 56b/m, cry and movement- present, SpO2- 89% (with oxygen), CBG- 84mg/dl. As per ERCP advice, oxygen 3l was administered through nasal cannula and 10% D with 4.5ml/hr was maintained.
