After reaching the scene EMT assessed the patient's vital signs which were normal. EMT and Pilot immediately shifted her into ambulance with Emergency Physician Dr. Babulal's approval. Positioning the patient onto her left side she then enroute secured intravenous access. The intensity and frequency of labor pain increased indicating that the birth would be imminent. Quickly progressing to the second stage of labor with crowning of baby's head saw in amniotic sac at the perineum. EMT asked the Pilot to stop the ambulance and prepared to assist delivery in ambulance.</p>
Prehospital Care Provided	<p>EMT asked the patient to pant. She then slipped the cord from neck then they delivered rest of body safely. EMT provided proper care to baby, who was weighing around 3 kg and provided warmth with the halogen lamp. After successful delivery initiated Normal Saline infusion, oxygen 2 lit/min and on the long way to hospital monitored the patient's vital parameters constantly. EMT assisted delivery of placenta enroute to the hospital. The mother and the newborn were shifted to Kulasekaram Government Hospital . Family members thanked 108 for the safe delivery and resuscitation efforts of 108 team.</p>

*- Ineffective Calls – Calls falling under the category of No Response call , Wrong call , Nuisance, Disconnected call , Missed call , General Enquiry call, and Silent Call are classified as Ineffective calls. These calls land in the call center and when attended by the Communication Officer it would either be a nuisance call or disconnected call or any one of the category as mentioned above.

** - Ambulance Busy – Whenever all the ambulances closer to the area have been assigned for an emergency case, and a new emergency case comes in the same area, the Dispatch Officer will enquire with the caller, if he/she can assign a ambulance from the nearby location. The Dispatch Officer will also tell them about the distance the ambulance has to travel and the approximate time it will take to reach the incident location. If the caller is not willing to wait till the specified time, then the Dispatch officer will close this case as “Ambulance Busy” after confirming with the caller.

*** - Life Saved count is an update that is received on a daily basis after verification of PCR and confirmation after 48 hour follow-up, there will be a change in the numbers reported as they keep on adding to the earlier reported life save count, based on the date the case was handled by the team.
