On examination EMT identified the imminent signs of delivery such as ruptured membranes,crowning , the length and duration of the contraction and it was a regular contractions with pains.After few minutes Mrs samundeeswari is completely effaced and cervix is 10cm dilated and feels like pushing. Emt stopped the ambulance and started conducting delivery , positioned the mother to lie back with knees drawn up and spread apart,elevated the buttocks and by using an aseptic technique emt created an aseptic environment for the baby .EMT encouraged the mother to breathe deeply and between contractions and to push with contractions,as the head crowns controlled with gentle pressure and supported the head and examined the neck for nuchal cord,there is no cord around the neck and suctioned the mouth and nose and supported the infants head as it roatates for shoulder presentation,with gentle pressure guided the infants head downward to deliver the anterior shoulder and then upward to release the posterior shoulder.emt hold the infant firmly to facilitate drainage of secretions and cleared infants mouth.Applied two clamps to umbilical cord and emt has cut the cord in between two clamps,after drying the baby she covered the baby with sterile towel and emt noted the time was</p>

*- Ineffective Calls – Calls falling under the category of No Response call , Wrong call , Nuisance, Disconnected call , Missed call , General Enquiry call, and Silent Call are classified as Ineffective calls. These calls land in the call center and when attended by the Communication Officer it would either be a nuisance call or disconnected call or any one of the category as mentioned above.

** - Ambulance Busy – Whenever all the ambulances closer to the area have been assigned for an emergency case, and a new emergency case comes in the same area, the Dispatch Officer will enquire with the caller, if he/she can assign a ambulance from the nearby location. The Dispatch Officer will also tell them about the distance the ambulance has to travel and the approximate time it will take to reach the incident location. If the caller is not willing to wait till the specified time, then the Dispatch officer will close this case as “Ambulance Busy” after confirming with the caller.

*** - Life Saved count is an update that is received on a daily basis after verification of PCR and confirmation after 48 hour follow-up, there will be a change in the numbers reported as they keep on adding to the earlier reported life save count, based on the date the case was handled by the team.
