of the category as mentioned above.

** - Ambulance Busy – Whenever all the ambulances closer to the area have been assigned for an emergency case,

and a new emergency case comes in the same area, the Dispatch Officer will enquire with the caller, if he/she can assign a ambulance from the nearby location. The Dispatch Officer will also tell them about the distance the

ambulance has to travel and the approximate time it will take to reach the incident location. If the caller is not willing
