ORDER:

During the Assembly session 2021-2022, the Hon'ble Minister (Health and Family Welfare) has made the following announcement in the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly (Announcement No.8):-

"ஊரகப் பகுதிகளில் உள்ள 2400 துணை சுகாதார நிலையங்கள் மக்களைத் தேடி மருத்துவம் திட்டத்திற்கு ஏதுவாக நலவாழ்வு மையங்களாக ரூ.35.52 கோடி செலவில் மேம்படுத்தப்படும்."

2. In Government Order first read above the Government have issued orders for launching the pilot project on Comprehensive Primary Health Care Services in the three blocks namely Krishnagiri - Shoolagiri Block, Pudukottai-Viralimalai Block and Parambalur- Vempur Block and permission was also accorded to utilize a sum of Rs.599.07 lakh. In Government Order second read above, the Government have issued orders for up-scaling the programme of Comprehensive Primary Health Care Services / Universal Health Coverage in 39 Health Unit Districts at one block per Health Unit District under National Health Mission at a total cost of Rs.4417.84 lakh.

3. In Government Order third read above, among others, the Government have issued orders for the implementation of Universal Health Coverage scheme in Tamil Nadu in the name of "Anaivarukkum Nalavazhvu Thittam" through State Programme Management Unit, Universal Health Coverage and Maternal Child Health established at the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

Centres in 2021-22 at a total cost of Rs.16701.67 Lakh as detailed in the annexure II to this order to achieve the Government of India target.

- ii. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted for placing Staff Nurse with GNM/B.Sc nursing qualification as Mid-Level Healthcare Provider in Health and Wellness Centres in Tamil Nadu on Contractual basis through respective District Health Society, subject to the condition that, a certificate should be obtained from the appointee to the effect that, they would be made aware of the purely temporary nature
- iii. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is directed to ensure that, the contract appointment shall be given by the Deputy Director of Health Services in the capacity of Member of the National Health Mission only and not as Deputy Director of Health Services and all these posts should be paid through National Health Mission only and never be included in State budget for the payment of salary under the contract payment head of account.
- iv. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to pay performance based and team based incentives for Health and wellness centres as per RoP approvals in 2021-22.
- v. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to conduct certificate course in Community Health Care with internship to eligible GNM Staff Nurses to be recruited on contract basis as per National Health Mission norms and willing to work in Universal Health Coverage Health Sub Centres.
- vi. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to utilize the untied funds to the tune of Rs. 545.4 Lakhs approved in RoP 2021-22 under Universal Health Coverage for formation of Patient Support Groups in all blocks in Tamil Nadu as per guidelines enlisted in G.O (Ms) No. 503, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 02.12.2020.
- vii. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to pool and utilise the funds received under IT sub. head (FMR 6.1.2.5.1) for implementing the 'Population Health Registry' in Tamil Nadu.
